Sunday 25 September

- **Moderator** | Pray for the Moderator, Rt Rev Dr John Kirkpatrick, as he takes time to prepare for his first Presbytery Tour to the Dromore Presbytery starting on 2nd October. Pray for God's guidance as he prepares sermons and addresses for a wide range of contexts during the forthcoming week.
