In October, Csaba represented IKE in the Unify mission conference in Vienna, speaking on Matthew 11, on what it means to be yoked to Christ. It was encouraging to see 120 youth leaders gathered from all over Europe to renew fellowship share and reflect on mission opportunities and challenges.



In Transylvania, the constant worry of the war in Ukraine spilling over the border has been an ongoing concern for many, and now, alongside this many have been impacted with soaring energy, food and fuel prices. At times of economic crisis, those on the margins are impacted the most, and in Roma communities many struggle to make ends meet. In October, the Diakonia continued with distributing food packages to vulnerable elderly in Mera but there is also a growing need to help families who survive on minimal income.

Pray that God would supply needs and sustain vulnerable families who worry about the spiralling cost of food and wood for cooking and heating as we face the winter.

In mid-October a team from Mexico joined the Cluj YWAM team to build a home for a Roma family in Mera. The foundations were completed in September, so the team were able to build the house in just one week.

We rejoice in this outpouring of love which provided a family with a safe and comfortable home and we pray that God will continue to work in their hearts, that they will find their place of safety, security, and shelter in Jesus Christ.



In the Mera afterschool program good news club, we will begin our advent teaching series at the end of the month. Also during advent we will begin a women's outreach, meeting weekly to prepare for Christmas with practical crafts and cooking, and spending time in the word of God. As we study the themes of Courage, Hope, Trust and Love in the account of the birth of the saviour, **we pray for the building up of good relationships, times of honest sharing and for the women to listen to and respond to the love, mercy and grace of God.**
