On the second week of September, the Presbyterian Church of East Africa (PCEA) will be observing the annual mission or 'Nendeni' week in Swahili. The climax of the week will take place on Sunday, 11 September. This is a time when the church focuses and prays for the unreached, for newly and for under developed areas.

On 18 September the infant baptism of three children in our London congregation is due to take place. The parents of the children are currently taking some classes to prepare for this.

On 24 and 25 September, the 'Kenyan's and friends in the park' event in London which was postponed from August, is expected to take place in a park near Barking. Our church being the official spiritual leaders, is preparing for it.
