AATEEA TEE in Africa book project

A few months ago, the AATEEA General Secretary, Rev Dr Kangwa Mabuluki and Volker discussed the possibility of bringing together African TEE leaders to reflect on the developments of TEE in Africa. The last book published on TEE in Africa is 30 years old. Many things have happened since then. Professor Eric Anun from Ghana kindly agreed to join the editorial team. During the AATEEA conference, we introduced AATEEA's first book project on TEE in Africa. The purpose is for TEE practitioners to reflect on the historical development of TEE in Africa and comment on the key challenges and the (untapped) potential of TEE for the continent.

One of the first major projects that Volker will do is to interview all the TEE leaders in Africa so that the concerns and ideas of all African TEEs can form the bases of all further reflection. Over 20 programmes sent representatives to the conference, while others joined online.
