The Good News Club children are discovering more of who Jesus is in our Series on God, The Bible, Sin, Jesus, Repentance and faith, Considering the Cost. This year 4 of our young volunteers are using the M&Ms sweets to encourage Missão no Mundo. (Mission in the World)

With a large Map and their Missão no Mundo tshirts (M&M t-shirts) they are sharing how God's people are commanded to be involved in sharing the Good News of Jesus with folks in other parts of the World. (not quite like George Verwer - but pretty close!)

In these short sessions of 7-10 minutes, every other week, it is great to see the excitement of the children as they get on an imaginary airplane and travel to different countries and then spend some time praying for that country. It is also great to see the young volunteers becoming more interested in what is happening outside their small community and discovering at the same time how big God's World really is.
