


## James and Heather Cochrane

Location: Porto, PORTUGAL Mission: Church planting




On 3 November, after a 12 week stay in N Ireland, we return to Portugal. It has been a good time to settle the girls (particularly Lucy) into university, to rest and reconnect with family and friends and to visit and report back in congregations about the Lord's work in Portugal. We are encouraged by the interest and support of many individuals and churches.

Comunidade Pedras Vivas (CPV) continues to grow and on Sundays about 60-65 people have been gathering from all over the greater Porto area (and beyond) to worship. This growth is largely due to the resettlement of Brazilians in Portugal. Even in the few weeks we have been away, a significant number of new people have arrived at CPV.

When we return we hope to take the month of November to visit each family in CPV, giving us the opportunity to meet new people, reconnect with our members and to generally get a feel for where everyone is at after the various lockdowns and other restrictions relating to Covid-19.

We are thankful for the relaxation of Covid-19 restrictions in Portugal and we hope to be able to resume some of our normal activities. The small group ministry will be one of the first things we plan to put back in place. This will give the opportunity for people in different geographical areas to meet in smaller groups to study and apply God's Word, to pray and to get to know each other better.

Currently at CPV we are taking part in a prayer and fasting campaign called "Juntos" (together) organised by pastors in northern Portugal. It started on 23 October and will last for 21 days. The purpose is to join the church to pray for every district in Northern Portugal, one person at a time.
