Location: Lusaka, ZAMBIA Mission: Early childhood education

During November it has been extremely hot and then the clouds appeared and we have had some terrific thunderstorms! One of the thunderstorms was really fierce and did a lot of destruction to our premises. But we are so thankful for the rain as this means people can plant food for the next season. I visited Ndola to meet with two of our ministers on what we hope will be an early childhood development building project beginning in 2022. We discussed a lot of the logistics of what has to be done in Zambia before such a project can begin. The blessing is that we already have church land, so we just need to build a structure. As a Synod we need to visit the Ministry of Education in Lusaka to discuss with them the benefits of such a project, and to make sure we do everything in line with government requirements. For this we value your prayers as getting a meeting with the Ministry can be challenging.

December is a busy month every year and I will be conducting a strategic planning meeting with some of our heads of department. I am also meeting with the community schools coordinator to see how best we can work together in the early childhood development classes in the schools. I will be having a week of teacher training with teachers from Southern province, and just before Christmas a Board meeting. In January schools will open for a new year.
