Location: Porto, PORTUGAL Mission: Church planting




At the beginning of September, we enjoyed a two-week holiday. It was so good to spend time catching up with our two girls, Alana and Lucy, who are both based in Belfast. On our first Sunday back in Portugal (18/09) after just 2½ weeks away, we spotted about 12-14 new faces at CPV! We have noticed that at this time of the year, when schools and universities start the new academic year, many immigrants, especially from Brazil, arrive.

We are coming near to the end of our current sermon series on the life and law of Moses. The new sermon series will be based on the "I am" sayings of Jesus, found in the gospel of John. Pray for James as he prepares and preaches through these rich texts. We are thankful for a few non-Christian visitors (including

some Portuguese) at church each week. Pray that as Jesus is clearly presented, the Holy Spirit will challenge and convict them.

During the summer we tried on several occasions to get our young people together. There are only a handful of teenagers in CPV and it was not easy to meet as some were travelling or had other commitments. As we enter the autumn season, we hope to form a small group specifically for them. We are thankful for a group of 3-4 leaders who are keen to help develop this ministry.



OCTOBER 2022

The new session of small groups began in mid-September. Five groups met to begin a new series called "Love your Church", based on the book by Tony Merida. This 8-week study will take us to Christmas. Pray that each participant will be encouraged and challenged about their involvement in the local church.

Graúdos & Miúdos is a new monthly ministry directed at young families. We had our second meeting on Saturday 23/09/22. We encourage CPV families to come along and to invite friends who wouldn't normally come to church. Eventually we hope that G&M will become known to and attract families who live near to CPV. Pray for this outreach initiative.
