

- As we approach Easter, staff in the Diakonia's
 afterschool programs in the Salaj county are getting
 ready to hold the Easter bible clubs. During March
 we were able to prepare the teaching material and
 deliver it to each location. We were encouraged by
 staff who desire to give children a solid, spiritual
 foundation in their early years, and are committed
 to create a safe space where children feel valued,
 protected and nurtured and where they can hear
 about, and experience God's amazing love.
- 2. Saturday the 8th of April is international Roma day, when we celebrate Romani culture, history and language. In Méra, it is an opportunity to help each child think about how we are all made in the image of God and how God calls us to treat everyone with love and kindness, and respect. This is especially important in communities where Roma children suffer discrimination and prejudice from an early age.



Prayer Points

- Give Give thanks for every opportunity to share God's word with the children in the Easter bible clubs, pray that children would respond to the gospel.
- Pray for each child who attends the Easter clubs, that the truth would be explained clearly and passionately and that children would understand the message of the Cross and resurrection.
- Pray for Roma families who face daily discrimination. Pray that international Roma day would be a day of reconciliation and hope among the children in the afterschool programs.
- Pray for the six newly confirmed young people in Mera. Pray they would be faithful in their walk with Christ and that they would shine Jesus to their family and community around them.
