
OUR TENT

We had mixed emotions taking the tent down for the last time... There were so many happy memories of children exploring inside it; eagerly touching, smelling, gazing at the items and asking questions. But now, the Tabernacle series was over and we were packing up our mini version of it for good.

Like most of our tent's furniture, the "covenant box" was made out of cardboard and spraypainted gold. But when John (aged 10) entered the most sacred part of the tent, where the box was located, he stayed there for a few minutes, looking around and thinking deeply. Then he told Teacher Claire: "The holy of holies is like the heart of God, where his presence dwells... Now God is inside us, our hearts have become the most holy place."

For two months the Sunday School teachers had been sharing how the Tabernacle was set up for the old covenant worship of God, and how we can have a new covenant relationship with Him through Jesus. So, it was a bit sad when the time came to switch off the battery-operated menorah candles, reminding us of Jesus – the light of the world, and share out the 12 loaves of freshly baked flat bread, remembering Jesus' words, "I am the bread of life!"

Once the coverings were removed and folded, the structure made of metal poles was dismantled and all the furnishings set aside.
