


"Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and they shall call his name Immanuel" (which means, God with us). Matthew 1:23

As this is our first Christmas in Romania we are looking forward to new experiences and traditions within the Hungarian and Romanian cultures. Steve is particularly involved in services in Tóköz. There are evening services in the week before Christmas Day and a special Advent music worship service will also be held. It is hoped that all of the bands and young people that are now involved in worship within the church will be able to participate.

For a variety of reasons, and due to this busy schedule, we decided that, for this year, we would not plan anything specific within Cluj Christian Fellowship (CCF). Rather, we would take the time to be part of what happens within Tóköz and other fellowships and allow this to help us plan in the future. We are very pleased to have been able to help facilitate the Carol Service for Julia and Lucy's school: this will take place in a large Hungarian Reformed Church in the city centre with the capacity to hold the large number (approx, 500) and maintain social distancing. This is a great opportunity for the English Ministry and CCF to be visible to the international community. This follows from Steve teaching a Year 8 History class (Julia's) on the spread of the Reformation, and planning a subsequent field trip to visit our church at Tóköz.

Rosie continues to teach English in the Kindergarten but recently this has been interrupted due to children and teachers contracting Covid-19 and the provision moving online. Rosie is hoping to record some short videos for the older children so they can continue to practice English.
