We believe God is calling us join an intercultural church plant ministry in Bodaszőlő a small village in Northeast Hungary in the Transtibiscan District of the Reformed Church, where we ministered this summer. We will work under the leadership of the Calvin Square Reformed church in Hajdúböszörmény, which is the mother church of the Bodaszőlő church plant, joining the small team and part time pastor who have been working there for almost a year now.

There are two main communities in the village, Hungarian and Roma, and there has never been a church there. In these early days joining the team in Bodaszőlő it is important for us to build relationships and network, to understand the vision of the team in evangelism, in building a fellowship, in their diaconal work, and in helping the small group of believers to live a missional lifestyle.

- Please pray that in this last period of ministry in the Diakonia in Romania we would finish well.
- Pray for all the practical details of our relocation to Hungary, for finding accommodation, packing, settling in.
- Pray for the team in Bodaszőlő, for good connection with the team members and leadership.
- Pray that the Bodaszőlő church plant team would preach and model the love of Jesus in the community and live out peace and unity.
- Pray that many in the village would encounter Jesus.
