## Location: Olkinyei, KENYA Mission: Church planting and Scripture distribution

The car was able to leave Olkinyei on both occasions with the rain coming behind, and therefore neither time did the vehicle get stuck. With much heavy rain predicted and falling heavily between these times of travelling, we could only stand in awe of our awesome God and bless Him for His grace and goodness towards us.

During the dry spell of weather, we were able to work at, and fix, a portion of the dirt road that is more than a little difficult to drive upon when the ground is saturated.

We were also able to fix the old Land Rover and get it up and going again – all the while having a seasonal flu.

We bless our LORD for the opportunity to teach after returning from Northern Ireland and are deeply grateful to our Father for His dear children within Olkinyei who preach, teach and reach out, and seek to bring Him glory within the church families and the wider community. At present we are in the process of prayerfully seeking to obtain God's Word and have them distributed to each home in our local area. We have ordered both Maasai and Swahili Bibles, as there are also people living within Olkinyei who are from other tribes. This has been a hearts' desire of ours for many years, but we also desired that it would be the Maasai who would be leading this Bible distribution and praying for and with each family/home that they visited.
