Rosa and myself were very thankful for the arrival of the taxi driver and his air-conditioned car which was then filled to capacity with Rosa and myself carrying boxes of panettones on our laps. Needless to say plenty of water was purchased to keep us going.

The children and teenagers who went to the book fair in the shopping centre had a great day out and it was really encouraging to see the books that they were now choosing. Each of them was given prize money to spend on whatever books they wanted for themselves. The list of books/novels they chose for themselves included, 'The Jungle Book', 'Tarzan', 'Little Women' and the 'Winx Saga' books. None of the children were interested in the colouring books or picture books as they all now wanted what I would call "proper reading books"! The woman at the cash desk was very impressed by their choices of books and also the discussion that some of them had with her about certain books they had been reading and what they thought of them.

Beberibe congregation are really excited about using the M&Ms in their street evangelism programme and are praying, in the words of one elder, for "a good catch of fish." After the training session on being 'Fishers of men' and using different strategies of 'Fishing' it is a real thrill to see them applying what they have learnt in their prayers and actions.
