Like everywhere, there was plenty going on in Cluj during the Christmas season. Here are some of our Christmas highlights.

Cluj Christian Fellowship (CCF) - Alongside Hungarian students of Kolozsvári Tirannosz Ház, we hosted a walking City Tour for nine International Students. We were delighted to host two of these students for Christmas Day lunch at our home. CCF hosted the Carol Service for the Royal School across two nights, giving us the opportunity to introduce the ministry, chat and network with a large section of the international community in the city.

In and around Tóköz - The Christmas Concert on 12 December in Tóköz was a wonderful celebration of the birth of Jesus and a great showcase for the musical talent being developed in the church. Steve was kept busy during the Christmas week of services: preaching, providing some technical support, and leading the band on Christmas Eve. Thankfully the Kindergarten opened just before Christmas giving Rosie the opportunity to tell the Christmas story.

Finally - Family friends invited us to a traditional Hungarian Reformed, St Stephen's Day Service in a village close to the city, experiencing some traditional Hungarian customs and sampling food. In the week following Christmas, we also were invited to the home of Romanian friends for some traditional Romanian Christmas fayre.
