SEVENTY TIMES SEVEN

Matthew 18 v 2/1, 22

Then Peter came to Jesus and asked "Lord how many times shall I forgive my brother when he sins against me? Up to seven times?" Jesus answered, "I tell you, not seven times, but seventyseven times.

PRAYER

Lord, I suspect the numbers don't matter

much in these verses. Jesus wanted to correct Peter's wrong attitude. Peter saw forgiveness as a duty and wanted to set a limit beyond which he would not go. Like Peter I too have to learn that forgiveness isn't like that. Lord, I would be in a very sorry state if you set limits on the number of times you would forgive me. So by your grace, help me not to withhold my forgiveness to others who may have sinned against me. Help me to remember the forgiveness you have shown to me and so set no limits on forgiveness. Help me to keep on forgiving until it stops being a duty and becomes an act of love. AMEN

Ephesians 4 v 31, 32

Get rid of all bitterness, rage and anger, brawling and slander, along with every form of malice. Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as Christ God forgave you.

Colossians 3 v 13, 14

Bear with each other and forgive whatever grievances you may have against one another. Forgive as the Lord forgave you. And over all these virtues put on love, which binds them all together in perfect unity.


PRAYER
