

Each of the boys and girls received a book of Joshua or Ruth and also a small box of daily verses from Proverbs for princes and princesses.

With dad out visiting me, he was soon put to work painting, putting up curtains, walking the dog, and had the privilege of preaching in Beberibe congregation (with me translating).

If I asked you how many pizza slices would you be able to eat in one sitting, I wonder what your answer would be?

Some of the young teenager boys managed to eat 10 large pizza slices at the birthday treat for those from the Good News Club whose birthdays fell into the months of July, August and September!
