As we continue to build relationships with those from our mother church in Hajdúböszörmény, the church plant team and the folks in Bodaszőlő, we are thankful for caring team members. We are starting to feel at home in Bodaszőlő and are so thankful for our partners in the gypsy mission team who are encouraging and supportive.

In March church gathered in our rented property for Bible study on two occasions and twice for Sunday worship, with new people coming along and great opportunities for building friendships. In March our women's group has been challenged by three Marys in the Easter story. On the second occasion, after bible study, the final hour was spent making pasta for needy families in the village. We give thanks especially for Marika who meets with Ilona to pray and plan the women's group each week.



At the end of March we began hosting a course run by the National gypsy mission called 'Together for the community', looking at community development as an aspect of mission. We give thanks for the time of team building and the developing of our team focus.

Our team desire to show the love of Jesus in Bodaszőlő by organizing programs to help the community. One such program is our Silver Surfers internet club. In April with the help of the youth group from the Kalvin Square Reformed church in Hajduboszormeny we will hold individual personalized internet classes for elderly who request help with using the internet. Some have signed up to get familiar with email, or for online shopping, others to learn how to use messenger to contact their grandchildren. Pray this would be a good opportunity to connect and also pray with and for those who attend.
