A pocket on the cover holds the revised parents book. This addresses concerns many parents face when their child starts school, and includes quotes from parents who have already been there.

This is a great little book to help a child to talk about anything they are concerned about at this time in their lives. It is also a great option for a church to give to families to show that they are aware that this is an occasion in their lives. Along with "It's Your Move" for those moving to secondary school, this book can be a vital resource for families facing transition.
