Our weekly good news club began the year looking at the inspired Word of God and its importance in our lives. Niki, a third grade girl told of how God spoke to her through last year's series on the 10 commandments and how she is continuing to seek to follow Christ. We pray for Niki and others like her as they walk with Christ and take this message to their homes.

International Cyber Safety day is on 11 February, and this a great opportunity for us to do some clear teaching on cyber safety, bringing challenge on what children are viewing, and at the same time helping the children to find and use online Bible resources which will encourage them in their walk with the Lord. On the evening of 11 February we will hold a special seminar for parents to discuss internet safety, taking time to encourage and help them to get access to the Bible app or audio Bible reading material, for those with limited literacy.

We praise God for the Dorcas group, women's fellowship which meets each Monday evening and for their keenness to receive Biblical teaching, advice and practical help. We pray for a hunger for God's Word, and for parents and children to get into the habit of daily Bible reading or audio daily devotions.
