Covid 19 in Malawi – update

The fourth wave hit over the Christmas break, but it also flattened out reasonably quickly. We only had 19 cases yesterday, compared to the peak of 1,168 at Christmas. The total Covid-19 deaths in Malawi stands just above 2,600.

The rains and tropical storm Ana

The rains were very late this year. Malawi, as an agricultural society, is dependent on the rains. They usually start at the beginning of November, but they came late - in late December. However, at the end of January, tropical storm Ana hit parts of southern Malawi. It caused widespread flooding, displaced people, and destroyed many crops. Part of the country is receiving food aid at the moment. The electricity supply is still noticeable disrupted.

ICETE Academy (International Council for Evangelical Theological Education)

Volker taught for several years in the distance learning Master in Theological Education programme at the London School of Theology. Unfortunately, the programme is closing down due to a lack of enrolment. Yet, training in pedagogy for theological educators remains a vital need. We are delighted that Volker was just invited to contribute courses for the ICETE Academy, which provides professional training for theological educators globally through an online platform.
