

Ministry in Cluj-Napoca continues, albeit at a slightly slower pace than has previously been the case.

We continue to support Poarta Regelui, a church plant led by Carmel and Ioana, a Romanian couple who spent some years living and ministering in England. The Alpha conversations in a coffee shop are on-going, albeit with a somewhat inconsistent attendance from guests, and we pray for God's guidance in this ministry.

The Bible Study Group for teenage girls has continued to meet, as we have studied together the book of Esther. It has been exciting to discuss the relevance and teaching of this story and how it applies to the everyday context of teenagers.

We find ourselves in a number of scenarios of pastoring individuals and couples through challenging times. One of these individuals in particular is not Christian, yet has specifically approached us for pastoral support - we thank God for this opportunity and trust He will open doors for us to speak faith and truth to this individual.
