## Note to minister or others taking children's address

Blaze the Bee has gone on a long trip over the summer to meet one of our global mission workers and learn what they have been doing to help others where they live, using their gifts and talents.

- **3.** Praise God for the food which grows in Kenya's tropical climate and ask him to provide for those who do not have enough to eat or are finding it difficult to feed their families at this time.
