Most schools opened in Zambia on 1 February 2021. I have not been visiting them yet as it requires overnight stays but I am communicating with the teachers by phone. So far, they have had good attendance by children and things seem to be going well. I am thinking of visiting one school in Mazabuka where I could do a return trip in a day – just to see how they are managing with all the health guidelines and young children! I had intended to spend about a week with the teachers as it is a relatively new school, but this is not possible yet under the circumstances.

In Zambia, we have not yet heard anything about a vaccine although I know that in South Africa they have begun a vaccination programme there.

I am still attending worship online and enjoying the many different services I have access to. I may attend an induction service of one of our ministers in a local congregation the last Sunday in February. I do miss the fellowship of being together.

I have been attending many webinars and zoom meetings in the last few weeks – I feel all 'zoomed out' some days as it is meeting after meeting. Sometimes I think I am doing nothing at all - just watching a screen. I am hoping to have our Early Childhood Development Board meeting on Zoom in March – some may not be able to attend due to network issues across Zambia, and some may have no access at all to the internet.
