A GBG Conference, which is a conference for graduates, professionals, and supporters of GBU (similar to Christian Unions, under IFES umbrella), is due to take place in Cullera, Valencia. The conference aims to challenge, teach, and support Christian professionals as they seek to serve God in the workplace.

The theme of the conference this year is "Everything changes but the Gospel remains". The speakers are Ruth Walker who is the Ambassador Transforming Work at the London Institute for Contemporary Christianity based in the UK, and José de Segovia a pastor in a church in Madrid. Ruth will be giving talks on how to transform your work, by knowing who you are before God, recognising God in your work and living out your faith in the workplace. José will be giving talks based on the book of Esther.
