Location: Cluj-Napoca, ROMANIA Mission: Outreach and teams ministry



The Summer is upon us... schools have finished for the summer break, the weather is heating up, pavement cafes are in full swing, tourists are flooding into the city, music festivals and events take place almost every weekend. There is always a new feeling of vibrancy in Cluj-Napoca during the Summer months.

Usually involved in a number of children's and youth camps and clubs, this year our focus will be on sustaining and developing our work with the Ukrainian community. Baby and Mum Club will continue to run on Monday, Wednesday and Friday. The After Schools Project, normally running on a Tuesday and Thursday afternoon, will increase to run 4 days a week, taking Wednesday off. Humanitarian aid and support for the refugee community is taking a shift in emphasis towards integration in local society and community, and so we are examining how to most effectively help this community to feel and experience a sense of belonging.









Summer will not be completely without kids' clubs! - we are very much looking forward to hosting a Team from Exodus, largely led out of our home congregation at Orangefield Presbyterian. When a previous camp project for this Team was unfortunately cancelled, we are delighted to have connected with the local YWAM (Youth with a Mission) Centre who had been praying for a Team to help with a kids' club that they were planning. God answered that prayer in a remarkable piece of His provision and sovereignty that our Team would be available. So, between 9th - 17th July we look forward to hosting Exodus Team 38, partnered with YWAM, in running the kids' club for 5–8-year olds, doing home visits, working in their community meals programme, and being part of the Women's ministry. We are also excited to have This Summer, ministry will look a little different for us. the Team come and be part of our ministry in Cluj Christian Fellowship at the weekend.
