Visiting the UK and Volker's Deputation

Initially, we had planned to be in the UK in 2020, but Covid delayed us.

In April 2020, Malawi immediately closed its airspace for a few months until it gradually opened in September 2020 (just in time for us to send our oldest daughter by herself to university in York).

Subsequently, international travel was difficult because of the quarantine requirements for unvaccinated individuals travelling to the UK.

Only at the beginning of 2022 were our school children in Malawi offered a Covid vaccination allowing us to plan a trip to the UK in the summer of 2022.

We have spent the summer here in the UK reconnecting with our home congregation in Harmony Hill and visiting our daughter in York and many of our friends here in Northern Ireland.

Jinhyeog and the boys return at the end of August to Malawi to start a new school year.

Volker will stay in Belfast until the end of September for deputation.
