

On the 23rd of January we packed up our house and made the move to Hajdúböszörmény to take up a ministry in Hungary at the invitation of the Transtibiscan District of the Reformed church. On the day of the move, we were greatly encouraged as a team of 9 made the 5-hour drive from Hajdúböszörmény to help and journey with us over to Hungary. We have felt greatly strengthened and welcomed by the fellowship in Hajdúböszörmény.

After a time of settling in, residency registration and other official paperwork, we will begin work with a church plant and gypsy mission in the nearby village of BODASZOLO.

The HAJDUBOSZORMENY MOTHER CHURCH began this church plant one year ago and hold byweekly services and community work including an afterschool program and mothers and babies' group from a rented property in the village. On the first weekend, we joined the team in organising a soup kitchen for 40 families in the village.

The team we are joining, is made up of members from the mother church, (Kálvin Square Reformed Church in Hajdúböszörmény) and national gypsy mission volunteers from Bodaszőlő. In these early days of relocation we are very much mindful of the call to 'seek and pray for the welfare of the city' and the need to pray for open doors for the gospel message, and clear, bold presentation of the good news.



Prayer Points

- Pray that the Bodaszőlő church plant team will be kept fresh and renewed in God's grace, pray for good teamwork, deep encouraging relationships with one another and unity of vision.
- Pray that the Holy spirit will be at work, that the gospel will powerfully work transforming hearts and lives of families in Bodaszőlő. Pray that God would prepare the hearts of those who will be part of this new church.
