

October has included preparation and implementation! In continuing to support two local government primary schools, materials have been purchased to help with the improvement/renovation of some of the buildings within their compounds. As we have not experienced the usual rains, the lorry transporting the materials has been able to make trips into the schools without any difficulties, and there are only three more trips to make. With all the materials in, it is hoped that soon the work will be able to be carried out in both schools.

In one of the schools, the nursery children are enjoying their new desks. The desks have not yet been painted in their bright colours, as the painter isn't coming until next week, but it was decided that the children could use the desks until this time.

In a joint initiative, this local primary school together with the community and the Mission, have agreed to make a new 'road' through three parcels of private land to connect the school with the families who have settled in the hills behind the school. Everyone is grateful to the three landowners who have kindly granted permission and it is lovely to see different age groups working together, clearing the bush and lifting stones, whilst the digger removes tree stumps and rather large rocks, alongside levelling the new road.

Together we are being cooked and dusted under the baking sun but are so very grateful to our Father for His strength and provision each day. There will also, God willing, be a concrete drift constructed at one of the seasonal river crossings. This is such a wonderful blessing to the children, and we sincerely thank our Father, as they will now have a direct route to school, no longer having to travel through so many bushy areas with the risk of meeting wildlife, including elephants (who seem to be enjoying drinking water at the Mission's cattle trough).
