Mission: Pastoral ministry and church planting




We thank God for how far He has brought us since the lockdown. Despite many challenges, we have continued with our ministry trusting in Him.

Food has been distributed to the needy through the faith group's food banks. The other challenge which emerged in the middle of the Covid-19 crisis is the racial tensions fuelled by what is happening in the USA.
