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Lawnfield House is a purpose-built residential home. Registered with the Regulation and Quality Improvement Authority, the Newcastle home offers respite care for persons with various physical disabilities, visual/sensory impairment, mild learning difficulties and older people.



Set in lovely grounds nestling under the scenic Mourne Mountains, Lawnfield House can accommodate 20 people in 18 bedrooms, 11 of which have en-suite facilities.

Our aim is to provide a high standard of accommodation and care to meet the complex needs of our residents.

The catering staff provide a nutritious and varied menu, meeting the needs of those with special dietary requirements such as diabetic or gluten-free.



Lawnfield House has 24-hour staffing, with the level of care required agreed with the Home Manager prior to admission. Persons who are entitled to funded respite care should ask their social worker to contact the home to make suitable arrangements.

Residents may take part in the daily devotional and recreational activities provided. Lawnfield House maintains a wheelchair accessible minibus to facilitate outings.
